Academy representatives currently meet as a committee six times a year and meetings usually start at 6.00pm and are finished around 8.30pm. All meetings currently are virtual but will be held school when the guidance allows. If needed, additional meetings will be planned.

Academy representatives are occasionally required to visit the school during the day for monitoring visits and are encouraged to support school events, where possible.

We offer new academy representatives a comprehensive and supportive induction. Full training for the role is also available.

If you are interested in becoming an academy representative, self-nomination is acceptable – see attached form, which will need to be submitted to the school office by 12.00 noon on Friday 14th May 2021.

When nominating yourself or someone else for the role of academy representative, you are nominating the person you believe has the skills and commitment to undertake the role. You are also nominating someone you trust to represent the views of parents when working with other academy representatives and the principal, to promote high standards and strategically develop the school. The academy representative's role is not to represent individual parents' views or to report back directly to parents.
