

Lesson 10: Estimating answers to additions and subtractions

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1. a) $4,000 + 5,000 = 9,000$
Lexi's score is roughly 9,000 points.
- b) $4,000 - 3,000 = 1,000$ Max has roughly 1,000 points now.
- c) Lexi $3,987 + 5,123 = 9,110$
Max $3,987 - 3,104 = 883$
The estimates are close to the exact answers.
2. $2,101 - 998$ linked with $2,100 - 1,000$
 $2,891 - 1,100$ linked with $2,900 - 1,000$
 $1,975 + 2,010$ linked with $2,000 + 2,000$
 $1,998 + 2,101$ linked with $2,000 + 2,000$
 $2,925 - 975 =$ linked with $2,900 - 1,000$
 $2,998 - 1,998$ linked with $3,000 - 2,000$
3. a) $6,152 + 3,025 = 9,177$ $6,452 - 2,005 = 4,447$
Estimates may vary
 $6,000 + 3,000 = 9,000$ $6,500 - 2,000 = 4,500$
- b) Explanations will vary but children should mention rounding the numbers.
4. $6,491 - 2,725 = 3,766$
 $6,000 - 3,000 = 3,000$
 $6,500 - 2,700 = 3,800$
 $6,490 - 2,730 = 3,760$
Children may comment that rounding to 10 gives you the closest answer although rounding to 1,000 is easier to do.

Reflect

Explanations will vary, for example children may round to the nearest 1,000 ($2,000 - 1,000 = 1,000$) or to the nearest 100 ($1,900 - 1,000 = 900$).
