Easter – explore the Story of Easter through the Story of Emmaus and the Story of Breakfast at the Shore; realise how the Apostles became aware of the presence of the Risen Christ in these events.

Writing Opportunities: Biography writing, story retell, explanation text, informal letter, writing a recount

Maths

Fractions – equivalent fractions; compare and order unit fractions/fractions with the same denominators; add and subtract fractions with the same denominator; solve problems.

Measurement – add and subtract amounts of money; give change; tell the time from analogue/digital clock; use Roman numerals; 12 and 24 hour clocks; compare durations of events

Geometry – draw 2D shapes; make 3D shapes; recognise angles; identify acute angles, obtuse angles and right-angles; perpendicular and parallel lines

Statistics – interpret and present data using bar charts, pictograms and tables; answer one and two-step questions using information presented in scaled bar charts and pictograms; collect and organise data; solve comparison, sum and difference problems using information presented in charts and graphs.
