

Pupil Premium

2014-15 Academic Year

At St. Ambrose's Catholic Primary School, we believe that all children are entitled to a quality education and primary school experience, regardless of individual circumstances. **Pupil Premium enables our school to utilise this additional funding in ways that we consider most appropriate in being able to provide for our young people.**

Any child who is eligible for Free School Meals, or has been entitled within the previous six years, will receive the Pupil Premium Funding. School can use the Pupil Premium Funding flexibly, meaning that its use can be wide-ranging incorporating curricular and non-curricular aspects of school life.

Pupil Premium Grant 2014-15 Academic Year

Pupil Premium Grant per pupil = £1,300 rising to £1,900 for 'Looked After' pupils
Total Pupil Premium Grant Received = £30,000 (approximately)

Curricular Provision

- Teaching Assistants in classrooms for afternoon sessions
- Teaching Assistants leading intervention groups during afternoon sessions
 - Phonics Intervention Programme across Key Stage Two (Reading)
 - Clicker Intervention (Writing)
 - Guided Reading
 - First Class Number (Maths)
- Nurture Group led by a Teaching Assistant during afternoon sessions
- A Qualified Maths teacher supporting Upper Key Stage Two pupils
- Teacher to support reading within KS2

Non-curricular Provision

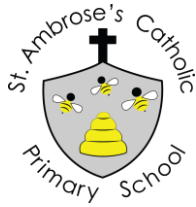
- Specific Staff training in Autism, Foetal Alcohol Syndrome, Clicker 6, Nurture

Resources Provision

- Clicker 5 reading and word processing package (for Teaching Assistant Intervention groups)
- Rapid Reading

Family Assistance

- Financial assistance for school trips, including residential trips
- Financial assistance for extra-curricular activities
- Provide uniform for those requiring financial assistance
